

NEL SEEGERS BURSARY
Girls in Grade 12
Criteria

Nel Seegers was a Guider in the Legacy Fraser Delta Area whose involvement with the Organization extended over a period of 58 years. Her commitment to the principles of Guiding and her dedication to the young women who joined the Organization lasted throughout her lifetime. This award was created in her memory. One bursary will be awarded to a girl in Grade 12 in the amount of \$1,000. The bursary is to be determined annually, at the discretion of the West Coast Area Awards Committee.

OBJECTIVES:

- This bursary serves to pay tribute to a long time member of the Legacy Fraser Delta Area who was much admired for her love of life and passion to Guiding.
- To honour a young woman's participation in Guiding and to encourage her continuation in Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible for this bursary the applicant must be:

1. Graduating Grade 12 at the time of submission and presently registered in a Guiding unit in Richmond, Ladner or Tsawwassen.
2. She is active in Girl Guides of Canada and has been involved for a minimum of three (3) years.
3. Applicant is planning on pursuing or already pursuing a program of full time studies. (minimum of 12 credit hours per semester) at a recognized post-secondary institution (i.e. university, college, vocational school).
4. The recipient is to continue her involvement in Girl Guides of Canada in some capacity.
5. She has shown participation within her community and is a good citizen.

GUIDELINES:

1. Bursary monies allocated will be issued only after proof of registration has been received by the Girl Guides of Canada West Coast Area Awards Committee.
2. Bursary monies must be applied to tuition and / or books.
3. The bursary must be used within 2 years of award notification after which time it will no longer be available to the specific recipient
4. A member will only be awarded this grant once.

Candidate will be evaluated and points awarded (as indicated on application) on the following:

- Guiding involvement
- Service / Volunteer positions – outside of Guiding
- Applicant's letter on the "Passion and Importance of Guiding and Service in her life"
- Recommendations, one from within Guiding and one from outside of Guiding.
